### SSC CGL Syllabus for Tier I 2018:

SSC CGL Tier I comprises of General Awareness, Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude and English Language.

Subject	Syllabus
General Intelligence and Reasoning	Classification, Analogy, Coding-Decoding, Puzzle, Matrix, Word formation, Venn Diagram, Direction and Distance, Blood Relation, Series, Verbal Reasoning, Non Verbal Reasoning
General Awareness	Static General Knowledge, Science, Current Affairs, Sports, Books and Authors, Important Schemes, Portfolios, People in News
Quantitative aptitude	Simplification, Interest, Averages, Percentage, Ratio and Proportion, Problem on Ages, Speed Distance and Time, Number System, Mensuration, Data Interpretation, Time and Work, algebra, Trigonometry, Geometry
English Comprehension	Reading Comprehension, Fill in the Blanks, Spellings, Phrases and Idioms, One word Substitution, Sentence Correction, Error Spotting.

### SSC CGL Syllabus Tier II 2017:

Mains exam will be conducted online and is an objective multiple choice exam. The major sections in the Mains exam are Quantitative Aptitude, English Language and Comprehension, Statistics, General Studies (Finance and Economics).

**SSC CGL Syllabus Tier III Paper:**

SSC CGL Tier III is a descriptive paper and will test the communication skills of the candidate. Candidate will be given to write Essay and Letters on social issues. Therefore candidates must be well updated on Social issues and current affairs. There is no syllabus for SSC CGL Tier III paper, however some topics are more important and can be given weightage.

The SSC CGL syllabus for Tier III Exam consists of the following topics. You must prepare for the following topics while preparing for SSC CGL Tier III.

- Social Issues** like Poverty, Education, Equality, Social Evils
- Politics, Schemes & Governance** Elections, coups, revolutions and agitations, political deaths, Appointments, Office holders and more
- Finance & Economy: Important Events in the Indian and global economy**, Demonetization, RBI Rates, GDP Rates etc.
- Environmental Concerns** like Pollution, Overpopulation, Ecology
- Sports:** Recent victories, tournaments, matches, Wins, retirements
- Geopolitics:** Chinese aggression in the Indian Ocean, Syrian Refugee Crisis, Rohingya refugees,
- Technology** :UPI, Payment Wallets, Vaccines, Social Networks etc.

**Statistics: Important Topics for Statistics are as follows-**

Classification and Presentation of Statistical Data, Measures of Central Tendency, Measures of Dispersion, Moments, Skewness and Kurtosis, Correlation and Regression, Probability Theory, Statistical Inference, Analysis of Variance, Time Series Analysis, Index Numbers.

**Syllabus for General Studies (Finance and Economics)-**

Finance and Accounts, Economics and Governance, Facts on CAG or Comptroller & auditor General of India, Micro economics, Basics of Economics, Demand and Supply. Theory of Production and Cost, Market Price Determination, Indian Economy, Economic Reforms in India, Money and Banking, Information technology in governance, inflation, Basics on RBI,

**SSC CGL Tier IV Exam Syllabus for selected Posts :**

The SSC CGL Tier III exam consists of a skill based test. Candidate needs to complete the

following tasks and it is qualifying in nature.

**1. Word Processing Test on MS Word: 2000 Key Depressions**

**2. Test in Microsoft Excel or Spreadsheets: 15 minutes**

**3. Test in Microsoft Power Point: 15 minutes**

Initially candidate must do a word processing test with 2000 key depressions. A part of the skill test will test the good typing speed. Candidates who obtain qualifying marks in the examination will be called for a Skill Test. The skill test will be of qualifying in nature and consists of Typing test. The candidates will have to appear for the stenography test and will be given a dictation for 15 minutes at a speed of 50-60 wpm. The matter will have to be transcribed on computer.

Candidate has to write one paragraph of about 50-60 words from the Data Entry Passage given to him in a separate sheet.

Candidate must possess knowledge of Microsoft Excel and prepare spreadsheet as per the given exercise. After completing the spreadsheet exercise, candidate must take a printout of the spreadsheet and submit the files.
